Dear Parents/Guardians and Students of Turner High School:

2013 Wisconsin Act 20, the 2013-2015 biennial budget act, eliminated Part-Time Open Enrollment and, in its place, established a new program for students entitled Course Options. Course Options still provides a means for Wisconsin students to take courses offered by other Wisconsin districts, but now also includes the opportunity for students to enroll in courses offered by charter schools, various institutions of higher education, and approved non-profit organizations at no cost to the student.

Specifically, the new Course Options law allows a pupil enrolled in a public school district to take up to two courses at any time from an educational institution. Wisconsin Educational institutions are defined under the Course Option statute as: a public school in a nonresident school district, the University of Wisconsin System, a technical college, a non-profit institution of higher education, a tribal college, a charter school, and/or, a non-profit organization that has been approved by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI).

Under the law, a parent of a pupil who wishes to attend a course under Course Options may submit an application, available on the high school website under the Course Options tab, to the educational institution the pupil wishes to attend no later than six weeks prior to the date on which the course is scheduled to commence.
